

Revocation of designation of Efrotomycin as feed additives.

1. Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) will revoke designation of efrotomycin as feed additives since efrotomycin is no longer used, produced, imported or expected to be used in the future in/into Japan.
2. Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) will revoke standards and specifications for efrotomycin stipulated in the ministerial ordinance.

Major revocations are outlined below.
